*Cover: In preparation for the Fifth Thule Expedition's westbound journey to Canada, Alaska, and Chukotka, the Danish crew traveled to Uummannaq (Thule) in Avanersuaq (Northwest Greenland) in summer 1921 to meet their Inughuit counterparts and to get sled dogs, field gear, and fur clothing that had been prepared in advance by the Inughuit.
